Board Workshop Topics

- Reviewed updates for superintendent evaluation.
- Sinking Fund renewal option and ballot costs discussed. The filing deadline is 2/10 at 4:00 p.m.
 - School funds cannot be used for campaigning and school staff cannot campaign.
 - The current balance is just over \$800,000.
 - The current rate is 2 mills.
 - Reviewed recent projects funded by the Sinking Fund.
 - Discussed potential upcoming priorities.
 - Plan to post a list on the website.
- Fencing update - Three of the four quotes did not include bottom rail. The Cornerstone fence bid did include it. The accepted bid went up by approximately \$6,000 to include bottom rail, but would still be the lowest bid.
- Solar update - Brewer-Garrett advised that an array at the Deerfield building will not save the district money considering current consumption and rates.
- Grant awarded for new apprenticeship wall.
- The new athletics complex scoreboard will include eight sponsorship placeholders to offset the cost.
- Discussion of Board meeting locations for next year and whether it makes sense to have all meetings in Britton because the business office is there.
