Solar update: Expected savings over 25 years increased from \$370,546 to \$1,748,944 due to improved financing rate by \$0.05/kWh.

Wellness policy 5707 selected for audit by the state. Wellness Committee established. The Board reviewed policy 5707 and is aware of the Wellness initiatives set forth by the committee.

Motion adopted 7-0

Sinking fund expenditures since 2017 at both buildings have been proportional to building sizes (excluding Athletics complex in Britton).

Pursuit of millage changes are not planned for May election. Further information will be gathered about expiring bond and August election options at a future Board workshop.
