Notice of Michigan's Safe Firearm Storage Law Requirements

This notice is being provided to all Britton Deerfield enrolled students' families as is required by section 1313b of Michigan's Revised School Code, MCL 380.1313b.

<u>Section 9 of Michigan's Firearms Act, MCL 28.429</u>, requires individuals to keep unattended weapons unloaded and locked with a locking device or stored in a locked box or container if it is reasonably known that a minor is likely to be present on the premises. This law applies whether firearms are in your own home or brought to another location.

Under Michigan law, if a minor gains unlawful access to a firearm this can result in criminal charges and penalties up to 15 years in prison for the firearm owner.
